(2) Participation in NPO activities




(3) Participation in volunteer activities



(4) Hobby, Culture or Learning activities


Social participation activities of the elderly(60 or older) %


N=505 (local communities) (multiple response)




employed & hope

Reason(Multiple Response)

1There are no suitable job for elderly.
